“1968”

“1968” is a 2018 docu-drama by the acclaimed director Tassos Boulmetis and producer Alexandra Andriopoulou focused on the April 4, 1968 basketball game in which the Greek underdog team A.E.K. played the Czech team in the European Cup finals before a crowd of 80,000 spectators in the Panathenaic stadium in Athens. A.E.K. never forgot where it came from, having been founded in 1924 of refugees from Constantinople; the film records memories of that disaster and the Greek families from Asia Minor whose lives were forever changed. For Greece the game took on a greater importance than a sports event, played just one year into the military dictatorship and at a time when the Greek nation badly needed a morale boost and heroes. 1 hr. 32 mins. Parking for CCP

From Interstate 10, take exit 257 for Speedway Boulevard East / University of Arizona. Drive east on Speedway approx. 1.5 miles until you reach Park Avenue. Make a left onto Park Avenue, then an immediate right into the Park Avenue Garage (northeast corner of Park Avenue and Speedway). Park, then go to the southeast corner of the garage, where the pedestrian underpass will take you underneath Speedway. The Center is the second building on your left, between Architecture and Harvill. **Parking is also available and free in Surface Lot 3039 (east behind the CCP) on weekends. This can be accessed via N. Palm Drive from E. 2nd St. (see map below).**
