**2026-2027 Scholarships for Greek Studies. Deadline: March 16, 2026**



Scholarships from the **HELLENIC CULTURAL FOUNDATION** are now available for University of Arizona undergraduate and graduate students for study and research. These scholarships are intended to promote excellence in the study of ancient and Modern Greek language, as well as ancient Greek history, literature, archaeology, anthropology, art, and philosophy. The scholarships are awarded to University of Arizona students who have demonstrated enthusiasm for and dedication to these fields of study and who intend to continue their studies of Greek culture. James P. Sfarnas Hellenic Studies Scholarships will be awarded to students in any field of Greek studies.

**Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be enrolled as undergraduate or graduate students at the University of Arizona for the 2026-2027 academic year or summer 2026. Students receiving degrees in May 2026 and not pursuing further study at the University of Arizona are not eligible to apply.
- Students may be enrolled in Modern Greek Language courses with the intention of enrolling for additional semesters of Modern Greek **OR** be majoring or pursuing graduate studies in ancient Greek civilization (language, literature, art, philosophy, history, archaeology, or anthropology) with the intention of pursuing further study in this area.
- HCF scholarship funding might be used for summer opportunities or research travel, tuition for classes in Greek studies, attending a conference or workshop, books or other resources, or other opportunities that will further a student's engagement with Greek studies.
- Previous recipients of an HCF Scholarship of more than \$450 are not eligible to apply again.
- Funds will be paid in May 2026 for summer research/study or in late August 2026 for study or projects at UA during the 2026-2027 academic year, including in Modern Greek language through the Critical Languages Program.

You will be asked for:

- Basic contact information;
- A short (250-word) essay on why Greek studies are important to you, details about your engagement with Greek studies in the past, and what you intend to do with the HCF Scholarship;
- Names and email addresses of two recommenders, one of whom must be a UA faculty member who has supervised you in your Greek studies. The HCF Scholarship Committee will contact them for references, if needed;
- Unofficial UA undergraduate and graduate transcripts, depending on your academic level, to be sent to [hcfships@gmail.com](mailto:hcfships@gmail.com).
